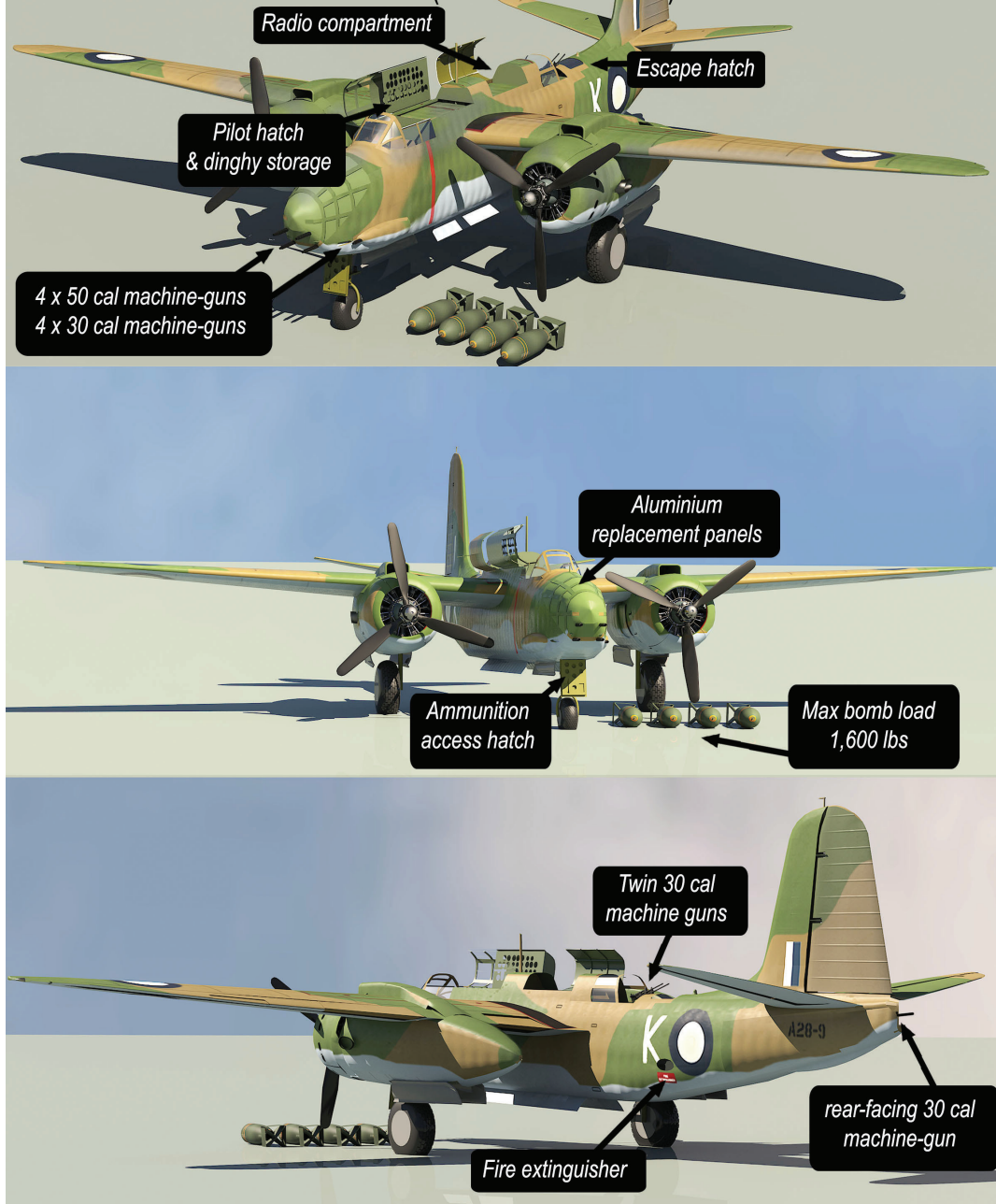

# Douglas DB-7B Boston (strafer modification)



*The ordnance configuration and armament of the DB-7B in RAAF service, although the fixed stern gun was only installed on a trial basis in Australia. The twin rear 0.30-inch calibre guns had no interrupter gear, meaning it was possible for the gunner to hit the tailplane. Note that the strafer modification added around 280 kilograms to the airframe, and in doing so reduced the bomb load to 1,600 pounds.*
