### Profile 32 Lockheed L-212 code L201

All ML-KNIL Lockheed L-212s were sabotaged at Pamaunpeuk to avoid capture, with the exception of L201 which was repaired in time to be evacuated to Ceylon. Note the partially retracted dorsal gun turret on this model.

### Profile 33 Lockheed L-12 code L2-35

L2-35 was among the batch of ML-KNIL Lockheed L-12s diverted to Australia where it was assigned as a staff transport to Brigadier General Harold George. This Electra was destroyed on 29 April 1942 at Batchelor, Northern Territory, when it was struck by a departing P-40E. George was fatally injured.

### Profile 34 Lockheed L-12 code L2-33

This Electra was one of two L-12s captured by the Japanese in Java where it served throughout the rest of the war. Illustrated in over-painted markings, it was used extensively for liaison and transport duties by the Japanese before it was reclaimed by Allied forces at Surabaya in May 1946.
