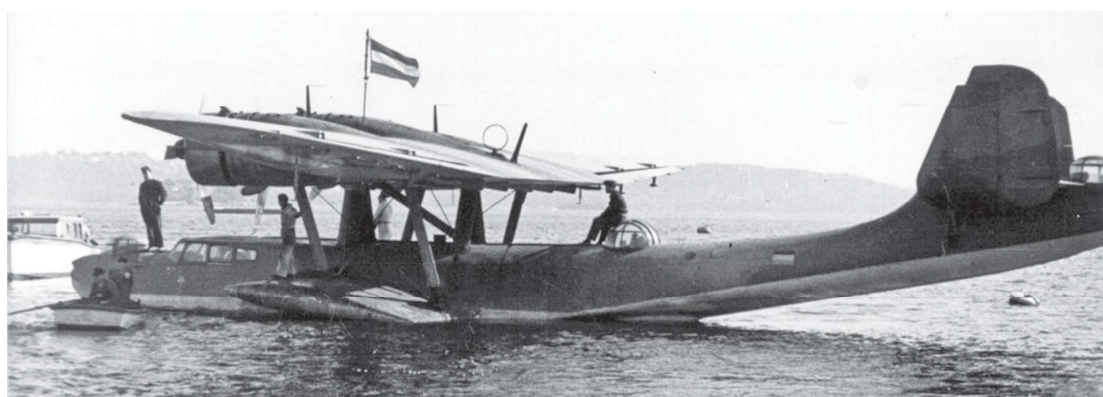


#### Profile 46 Do-24K MLD serial X-32

On 9 January 1942, while transporting cattle to Singapore, the Dutch ship SS *Camphuys* was sunk in the Java Sea by a torpedo from Japanese submarine *I-58*. The submarine surfaced and set the ship afire with shells after which X-32 alighted and rescued 54 survivors.

#### Profile 47 Do-24K MLD serial X-1

This Dornier departed Java for Australia on 2 March 1942 overloaded with evacuees. On the morning of 3 March in Roebuck Bay about a mile offshore Broome, it was strafed and destroyed by A6M2 Zeros from No. 3 *Ku*. Note that at this late stage it carried the Dutch flag insignia.
