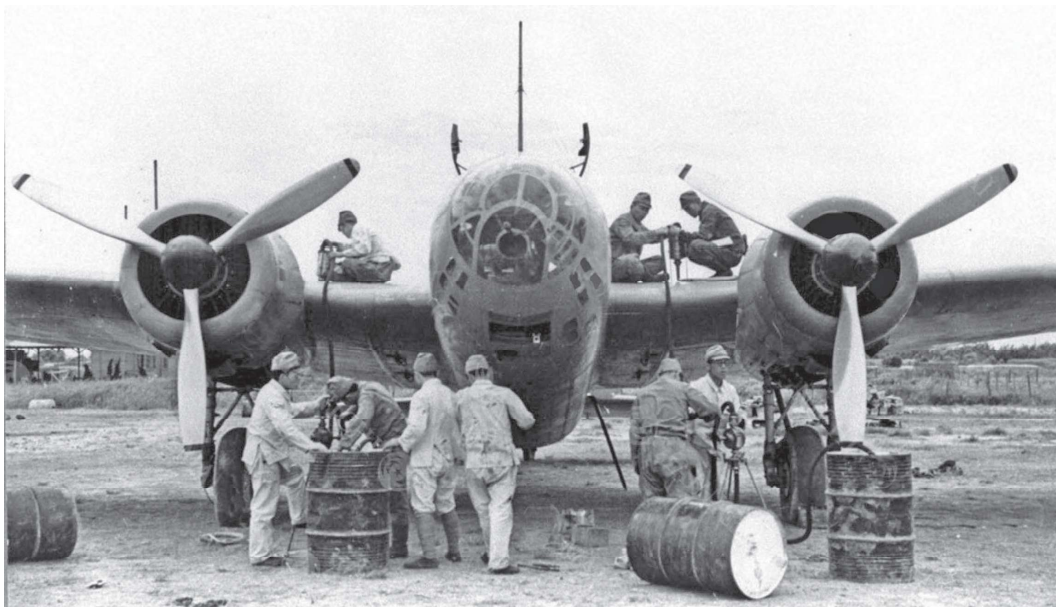


## NEW GUINEA EAGLES
