

SPRINGS & VOLCANOES, IT WAS
OCCUPIED BY THE JAPANESE NAVY
FROM 1942 TO 1945. THE KANJI
OPPOSITE MEANS "KIKAN SHIKENDAI"
- "ENGINE TEST STAND". THE RADIAL
ENGINE IS FROM A NAKAJIMA E8N2
'DAVE' FLOATPLANE ASSIGNED TO
NEMOTO'S SHIP WHILE AT RABAUL.

THE DUDE OPPOSITE WITH SAFARI HELMET IN SHARP IJN WHITES IS LT TAKEDA SHIGEKI, COMMANDER OF THE DETACHMENT. THESE GUYS ARE AT MALAGUNA NEAR RABAUL AROUND FEBRUARY 1942. YOU WILL SOON SEE MORE OF TAKEDA *ET AL.*

BEING NEMOTO'S APPLICATION TO THE COMMANDER OF
YOKOSUKA NAVAL AIR GROUP TO REFUND EXPENSES FOR
THE TRANSFER OF HIS WIFE KANEKO AND DAUGHTER TO
YOKOSUKA WHERE HE ARRIVED 19 SEPTEMBER 1941.

HIS FAMILY FOLLOWED HIM A MONTH LATER FROM THEIR HOME AT 2374 NISHI YOKOMICHI, HIROMOTO MACHI, KURE. THIS IS HOW HE SCRIPTED HIS NAME IN KANJI.
